Tree Memorial Program

The Whitehouse Memorial Tree Planting Program is designed to give individuals the opportunity to create a lasting memorial by donating trees in memory of relatives and friends or in honor of a commemorative occasion.

- Memorial plantings will be located along the Wabash Cannonball Trail or in Village parks
- The exact location and timing of each tree planting will be determined in accordance with the Whitehouse Tree Commission Master Plan.
- Trees may be selected by the donor from the attached list of approved/suggested trees
- The cost of \$265 to participate in the Memorial Tree program is the responsibility of the donor and includes:
 - Tree with a 1-2 inch caliper trunk (donors choice from approved list)
 - Planting, mulching, proper pruning and tree maintenance for the first five years after planting
 - 4 x 8 inch engraved brick paver positioned at time of planting. Indicate lettering to be engraved on 3 lines, 12 characters per line.

SUGGESTED STREET TREES – VILLAGE OF WHITEHOUSE, OHIO

- Small trees require a minimum 4' x 4' growing space
- Medium trees require a minimum of 6' x 8' growing space
- Large trees require a minimum of 8' x 8' and planted no less than 30' on center
